

Boughton Golf Club - Local Rules

Out of Bounds (Rule 18.2)

- a) The course-side edge of any wall, fence, hedge or line of white stakes defines the boundary of the course;
- b) On or beyond any white line defining the boundary of the course including, in either case, the edge of any internal out of bounds (holes 13 & 18).

OUT OF BOUNDS ARE DEFINED BY WHITE MARKER STAKES

Young Trees - identified by being staked (whether attached or not) or plastic protected are no play zones:

If a player's ball lies anywhere on the course other than in a penalty area and it lies on or touches such a tree or such a tree interferes with the player's stance or area of intended swing, the player must take relief under **Rule 16.1f**.

If the ball lies in a penalty area, and interference to the player's stance or area of intended swing exists from such a tree, the player must take relief either with penalty under Rule 17.1e or with free relief under **Rule 17.1e(2)**.

Bunkers (Rule 12) - before playing your ball loose impediments and movable instructions including stones may be removed - **Rule 12.2**.

Penalty Areas (Rule 17) - includes bodies of water which are defined with either red or yellow stakes. Relief can be taken under one penalty stroke - see **Rule 17.1d**.

Immovable Obstructions (Rule 16.1) - include: All artificially surfaced roads, paths and winter tees on the course, including those covered with wood chips and areas where the artificial surfacing material has been transferred. All other paths and tracks are integral parts of the course. Free relief may be taken by dropping the ball within one club length of the NEAREST POINT OF RELIEF, not nearer the hole.

When playing the 6th Hole. If your ball is lying on or your stance affected by the path alongside the left of the last bunker or left of the green, then a free drop may be taken from the defined white post. Relief to be taken two club-lengths from the white post, no nearer the hole.

When playing the 9th Hole. If your ball

is lying on or your stance affected by the path alongside the left of the green, then a free drop may be taken from the defined white post (near the wooden walkway). Relief to be taken two club-lengths from the white post, no nearer the hole.

Ground Under Repair (Rule 16.1) - PLAYERS MUST TAKE RELIEF FROM GUR

- a) Any area encircled by a white or blue line.
- b) Any area of damaged ground in the general area that is considered by the green keeping staff to be an abnormal course condition.

Immovable Obstructions (Rule 16.1) - The building on the right hand side of the 8th hole is an immovable obstruction.

Fixed Sprinkler Heads (Rule 16.1) are immovable obstructions. The player has the option to take free relief when such immovable obstructions are close to the putting green and on the line of play as follows:

Ball in General Area. The player may take relief under Rule 16.1b if an immovable obstruction is on the line of play, and within two club-lengths of the putting green, and within two club-lengths of the ball. Exception - No Relief if Line of Play Clearly Unreasonable. There is no relief under this **Local Rule 5.2** if the player chooses a line of play that is clearly unreasonable.

Wrong Putting Green (Rule 13) - A ball coming to rest on a wrong green or physically interferes with your area of intended stance or swing then free relief may be taken within one club-length of the NEAREST POINT OF RELIEF not nearer the hole - see **Rule 13.1f**.

The Fire Point

The fire point is sited in the car park outside the main entrance.

Etiquette

Only recognised golf apparel & shoes to be worn on the golf course.

The maximum number of players allowed in one match or group is FOUR.

Defibrillator can be located in the Hotel.
